Survey information

Oftentimes, requesting an update to an existing survey can save costs, so I'd start by calling the survey company that completed the most recent one for your house. Please make sure to request that the following information is included on the survey:

- A. property lines and easements
- B. building and flatwork footprints
- C. all existing building finished floor heights labeled in relation to the topographic information
- D. site fences; indicate fence material
- E. all tree locations (8" diameter and larger), note the trunk diameter and species
- F. *topography lines in reference to sea level; topography lines can be omitted for some projects, but they must be included if you are considering landscape design, new construction, have a two-story home or plan to add a second story addition.
- G. location of gas, water, and wastewater utilities including gas meter, water meter, wastewater meter, and cleanouts, etc.
- H. location of electrical utilities including all utility pole locations near the property and the heights of the primary and neutral power lines. Please see diagram below (provided by AE).
